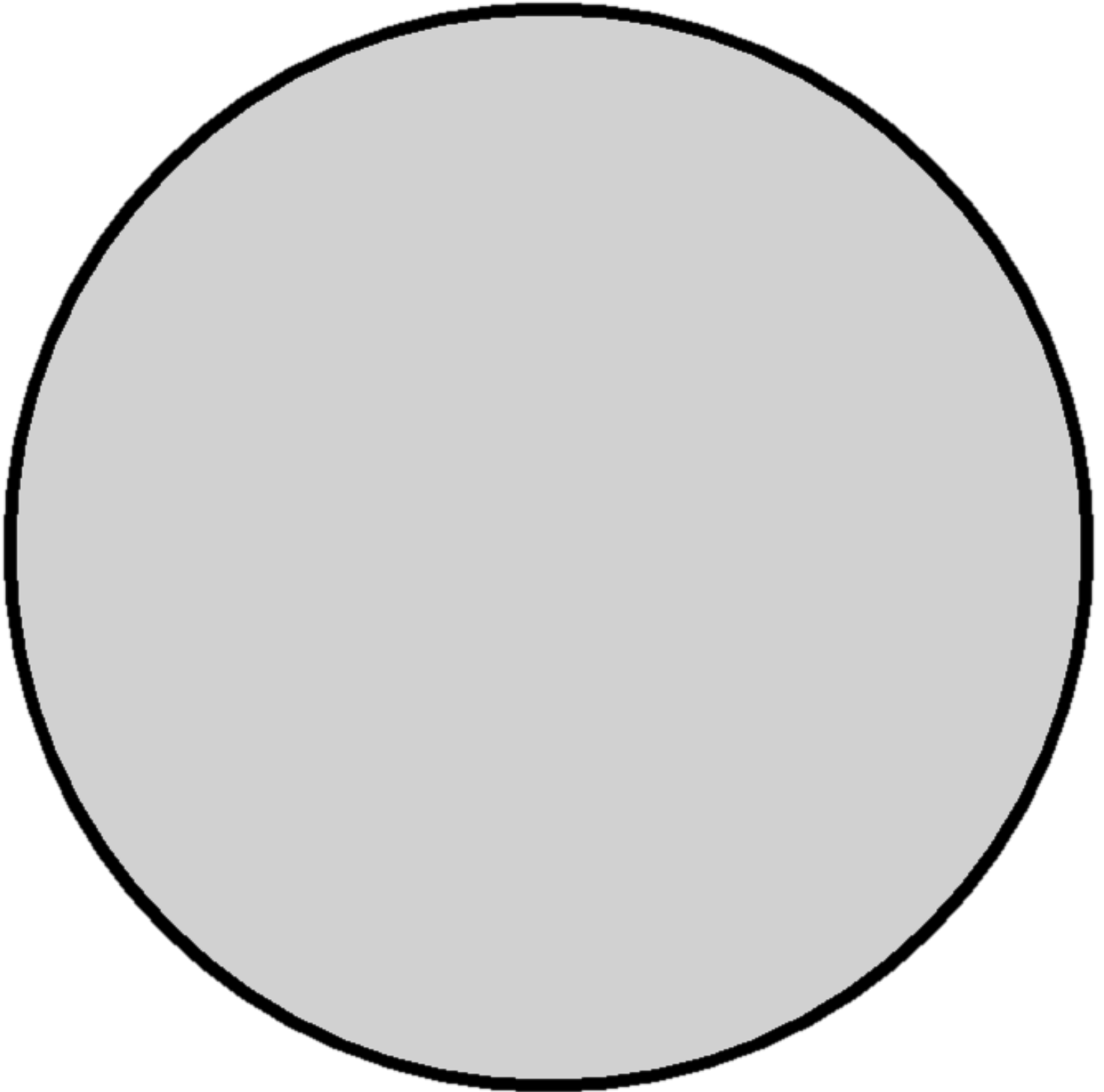


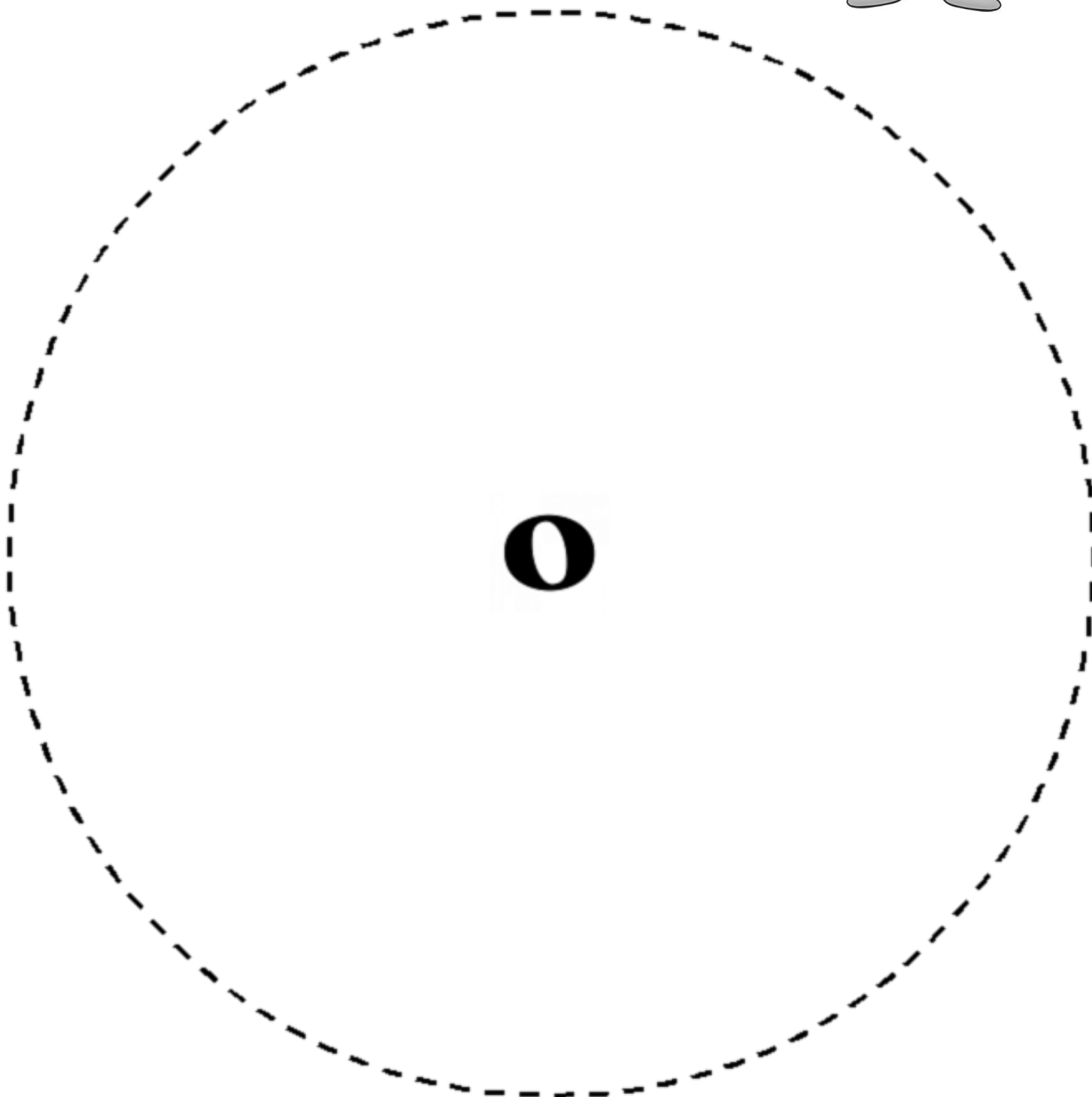
## **Notation “Nutrition” – Let’s make a Percussion Pizza!**

Another way to look at the difference between music notes is to think of them as different slices of pizza. A whole note (or a whole pie) would be a pizza that has yet to be sliced. Half notes would be the two parts of a pizza that has been cut in half. Quarter notes equal four cuts of pizza (or four quarters). Eighth notes are eight cuts, etc.

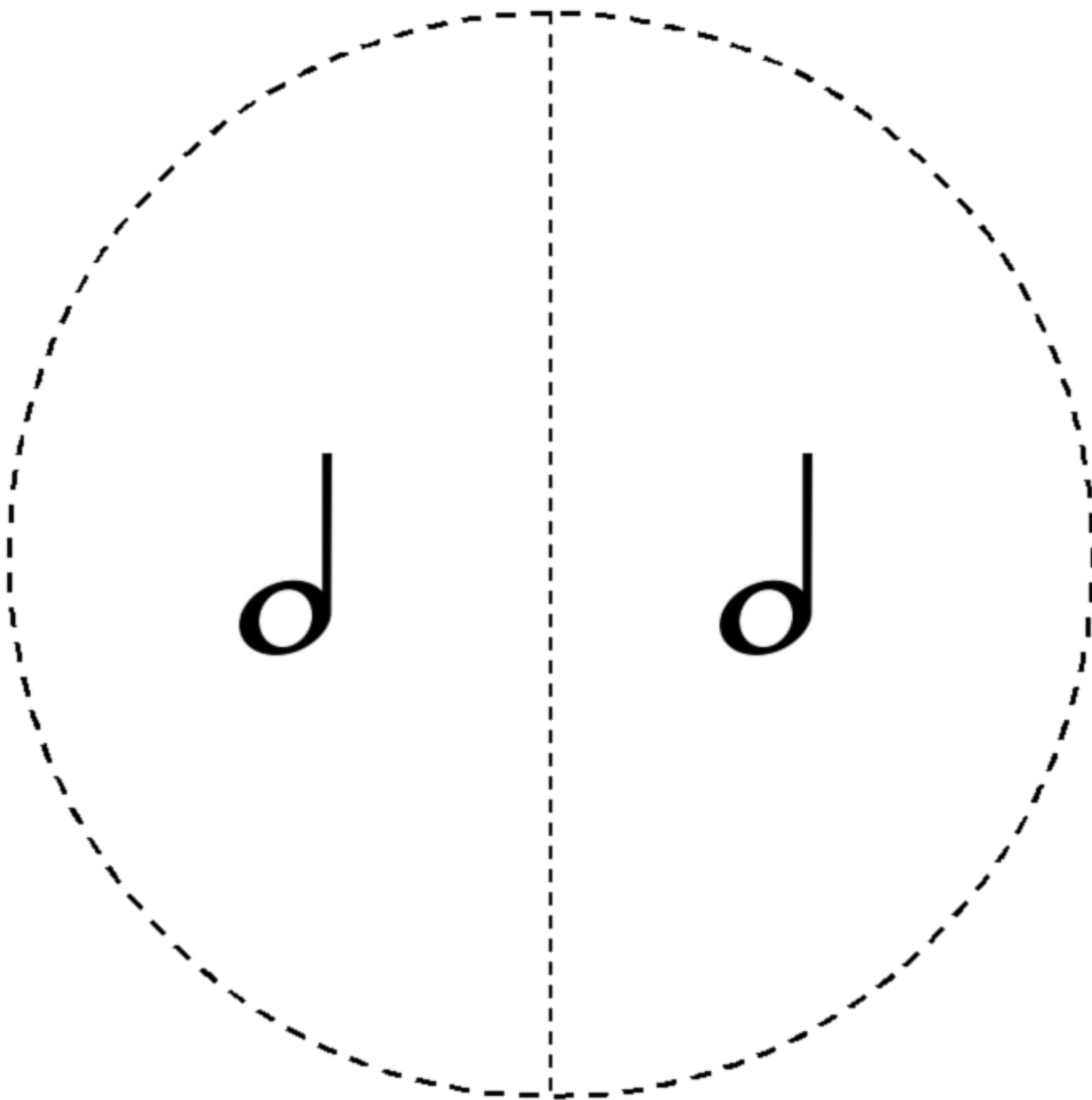

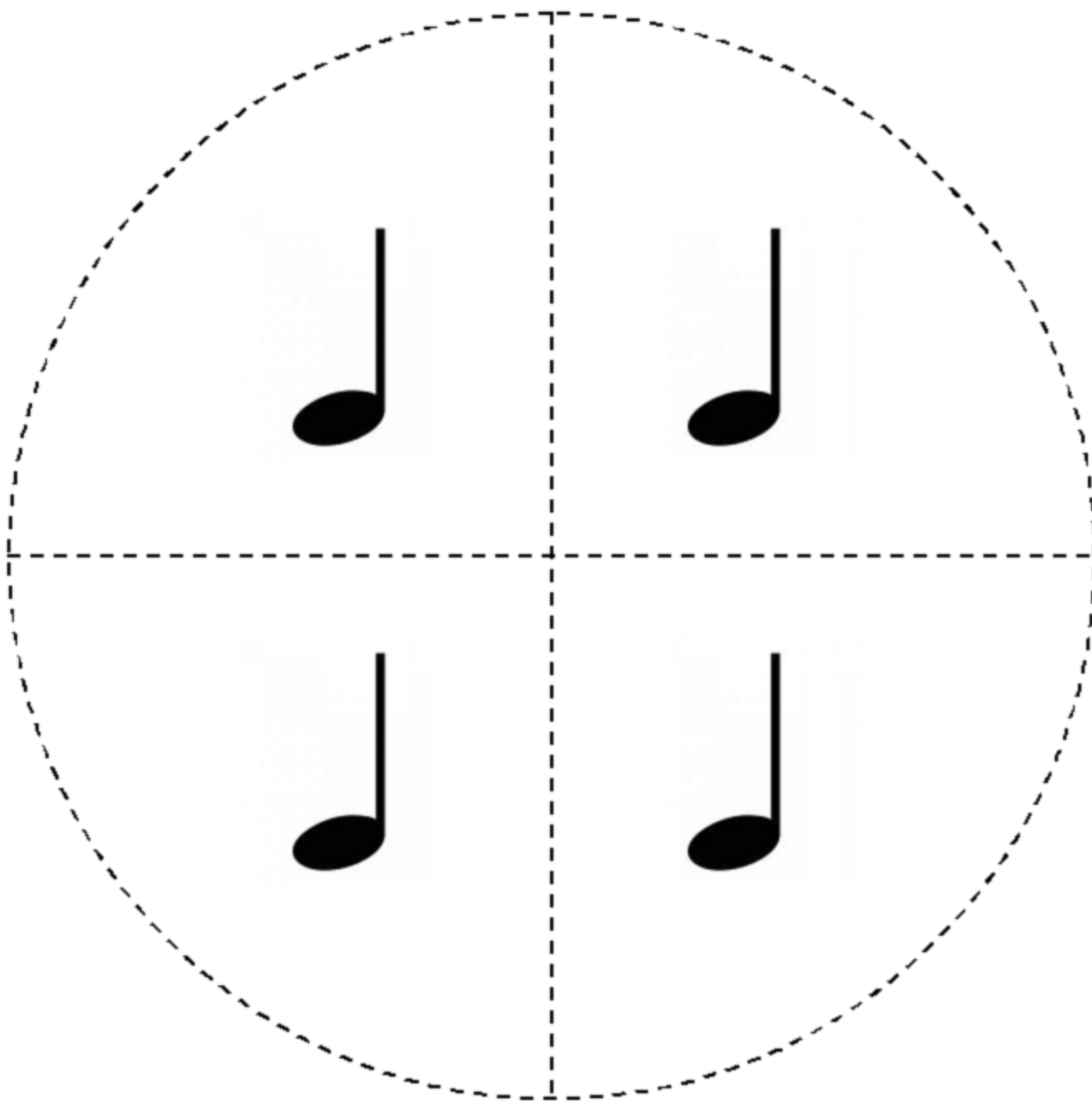

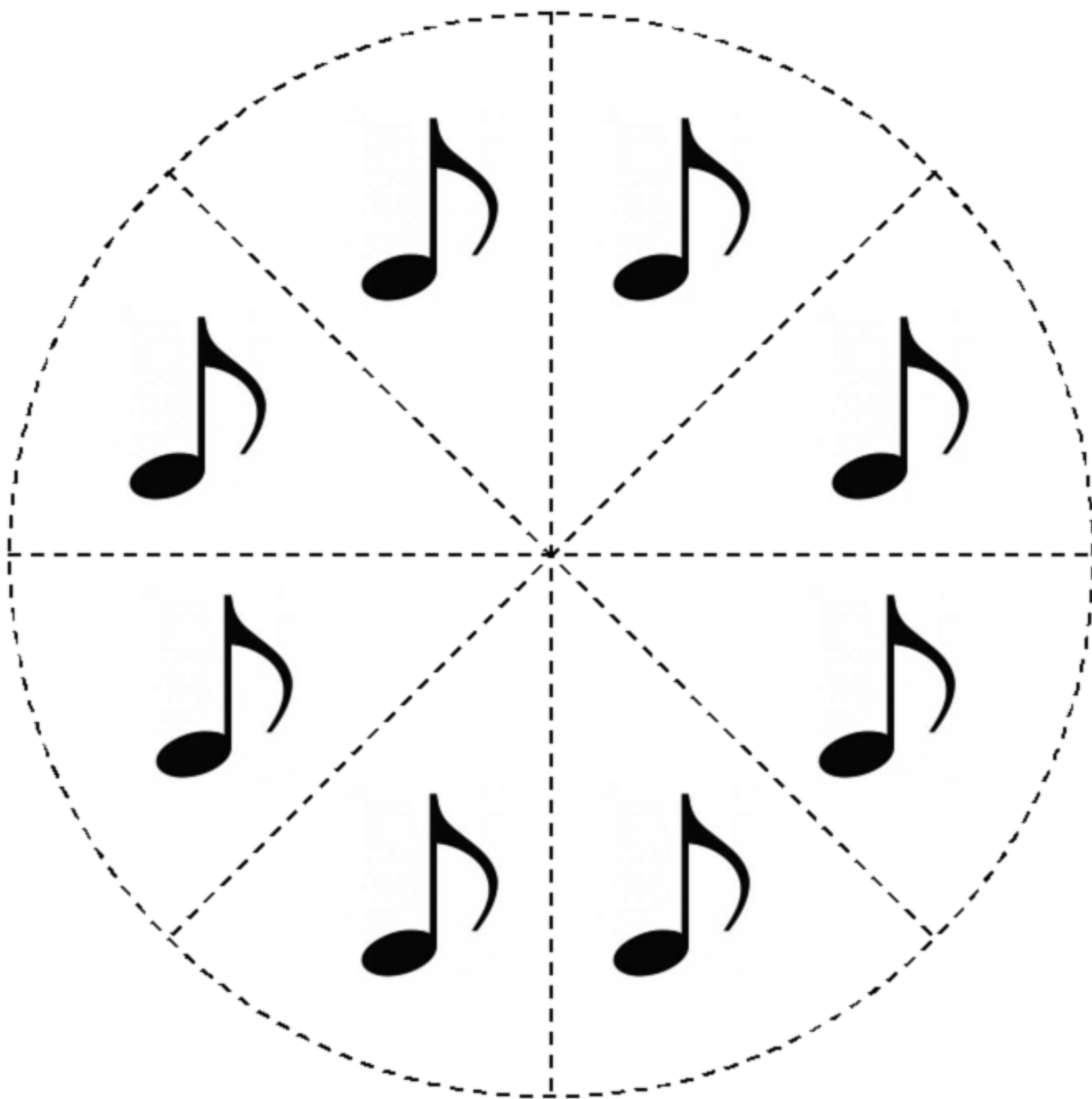
